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Plan after graduating?

While working as a Research Assistant in Liverpool John Moores University I was bitten by the research bug.

Did that change? If so, how?

I had my first experiences of teaching through demonstrating in practical classes during my MPhil, teaching master's degree students at UCLAN and then lecturing on a residential EMBO course whilst I was a post-doc at the Babraham Institute. During my early years at Kingston University I tried to balance teaching with developing my research but it was helping to set up a new School of Pharmacy at the University, and developing a new course, that piqued my interest in learning & teaching and led me to develop a new career as a teacher and pedagogical

What are your special interests/achievements in education?

The award of a University Teaching Fellowship enabled me to carry out teaching across the '1992 divide' on the student learning experience; this was a study of collaboration between a pre-1992 and a post-1992 higher education institution in the UK. Through a Physiological Society eaching Grant I have further researched the potential for collaborations between universities and I am also interested in training the next generation of university teachers, having recently run two "New to eaching" workshops for the HEA and the Royal Society of Biology.
