What has happened in the last year (1)

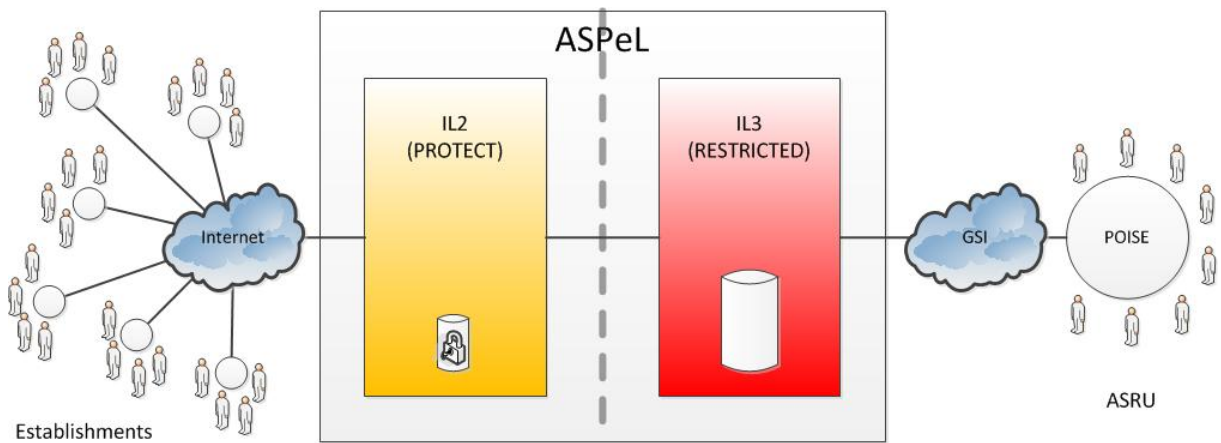


- Development of CBP terminated at very short notice due to commercial reasons, outside of control of ASRU
- ASRU learned from the development of CBP in looking at a different solution including the development of functional & non functional requirements
- We now have a single supplier – WTG - Services provided
 - Design, development, testing, delivery
 - Hosting, support and maintenance for a five-year period

Thinking about the new solution

- The implementation of the new EU Legislation and Bill has meant we have had to look at processes as well as developing the IT solution with the consequent risks
- Solution under rapid development for ASRU - Web application based on Drupal, a widely used Content Management System (CMS) and framework
- Rapid development means that we are building small sections and testing as we move to the next part

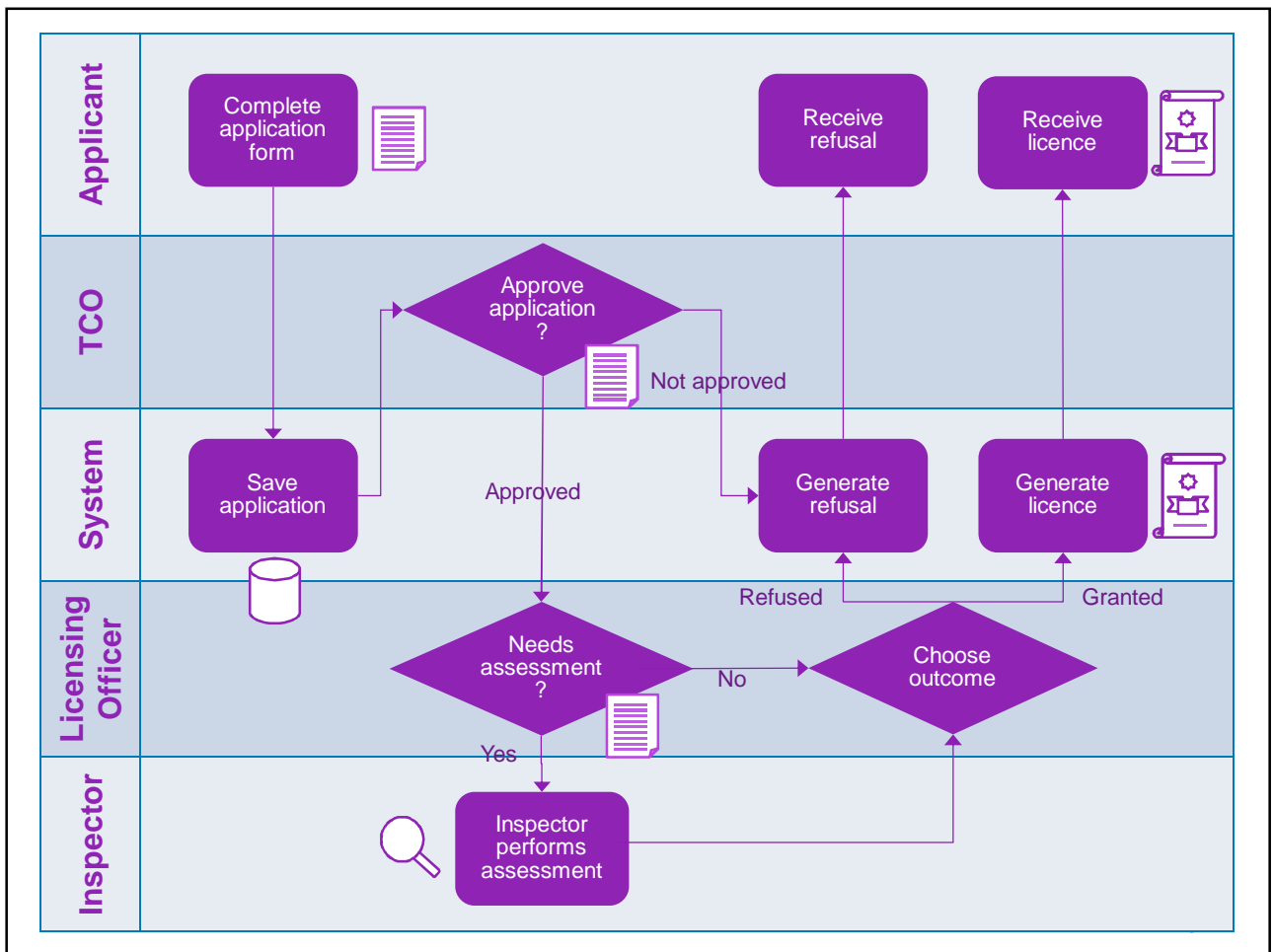
