## Intermediate Biology Olympiad

### About the competition

The Intermediate Biology Olympiad challenges students' biology knowledge and encourages them to continue studying the biosciences beyond school/college.

**The Intermediate Biology Olympiad 2018 will take place between 15th – 21st June 2018.** The competition consists of a one-hour multiple choice test taken online in schools under staff-supervised conditions at any time convenient during the competition dates. Questions will be set on topics students are likely to have covered at GCSE and in their first year of A level.


Students who take part in the competition are encouraged to reference their participation in their further/higher education applications.

The Intermediate Biology Olympiad is organised by the [UK Biology Competitions](#) committee and administered by the Royal Society of Biology.

### Prizes

Top scoring students are rewarded with publicly recognised certificates, and will be offered the opportunity to attend an awards ceremony at IET: London, Savoy Place. High scoring students will also be invited to one-day Field Studies Council course exploring the ecology of a urban park.

Every student who takes part in the competition is eligible to receive free [BioNet membership](#) for one year.






